Since 1975, **Leadership Boise (LB)** has focused on identifying and educating future leaders. Each year, up to 54 leaders are selected to participate in this two-year, masters-like community leadership program. During the first year, participants will spend one full day each month focusing on a range of topics including Business, Health Care, Government, Education, Quality of Life, Media, Legal/Social, and Infrastructure/Environment. During year two, participants will put their knowledge to work by taking action and planning sessions for the incoming class of Leadership Boise and the Leadership Boise Academy (program for juniors in high school).

TIMELINE

- **February – April 10:** Applications are available
- **May:** Interviews
- **June:** Final selections are made and class announced
- **August 14-15, 2020:** Opening Retreat (attendance is mandatory to participate in LB)
- **May 2022:** Graduation

Tuition is \$1,950 for two-year program: includes meals, transportation and program materials.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



Who can apply?

Any individual that is employed by a member company of the Boise Metro Chamber.

What is the time commitment?

Leadership Boise is a two year program.

Year 1 (August - May): There is one **full day** session each month. Participants may not miss more than two sessions during the first year.

Year 2 (June - May): Participants plan 2-3 sessions for the incoming Year 1 class. The average time spent planning and attending your assigned sessions is 4 - 6 hours. In addition, there is one **required** 2-hour meeting the first Thursday morning of each month.

What is the recommended level of experience?

Our participants are typically mid-management to senior-level employees.



What makes a good candidate?

Individuals who:

- » Are interested in building strong relationships to their community and business leaders.
- » Want to invest in their community and make a difference, long term.
- » Want to grow personally and professionally through leadership development.
- » Are currently involved in the community through boards, committees and other volunteer efforts.



What industries are represented?

Every industry. Participants represent a variety of industries and fields including small and corporate business, nonprofit, legal, government, financial, education, healthcare, and military... just to name a few.

What is the anticipated age range?

Any professional in the workplace that is over 21. The participants range from 27 - 55 years old.

What is the investment?

Tuition is \$1,950. There are a limited number of scholarships available.
